Day 01: 22 Sep 2027, Wed | Arrival in Tokyo

Flight details: TBC – International air arranged separately

Welcome to Japan!

Arrive in Tokyo and meet your English-speaking guide at the airport. Enjoy a comfortable assisted transfer to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free at leisure, allowing you to rest after your flight or explore the surrounding area at your own pace.

Day 02: 23 Sep 2027, Thu | Tokyo Highlights & Sumo Experience

After breakfast, early morning sumo stable visit to observe authentic **sumo training**, followed by a half-day Tokyo city tour that begins at the tranquil Meiji Shrine, continues through the vibrant youth culture of Harajuku's Takeshita Street, moves on to the iconic Shibuya Crossing and the nearby Hachiko Statue, and ends with a relaxing stroll through either Ueno Park or Shinjuku Gyoen Garden, offering a balanced mix of traditional culture, modern city energy, and peaceful nature.

Day 03: 24 Sep 2027, Fri | Tokyo's Cultural & Culinary Highlights

Starts with exploring the lively **Tsukiji Outer Market**, where guests can wander through stalls offering fresh seafood, street snacks, and traditional kitchen goods, followed by lunch at a local restaurant to enjoy authentic Japanese flavors. The day continues with a visit to the impressive **Tokyo Skytree (Cable Car)** for sweeping panoramic views of the city, and concludes with an engaging sushi-making experience, where participants learn to prepare sushi with hands-on guidance from a professional chef.

Day 04: 25 Sep 2027, Sat | Tokyo - Hakone

A journey from Tokyo to Hakone featuring a scenic cruise on **Lake Ashi** with picturesque mountain views, followed by a ride on the Hakone Ropeway offering sweeping vistas over the volcanic landscape, and a visit to the iconic **Owakudani Valley**, known for its active sulfur vents, hot springs, and famous black eggs, ending with a traditional kaiseki-style dinner in hotel showcasing beautifully presented, multi-course seasonal Japanese cuisine.

Day 05: 26 Sep 2027, Sun | Hakone – Takayama via Nagoya

A scenic travel day from Odawara to Nagoya and onward to Takayama via Shinkansen and the Ltd. Express, followed by an immersive walk through Sanmachi-suji, the beautifully preserved old town known for its traditional wooden streets and artisan shops, and ending with a sake tasting tour, offering a flavorful introduction to Takayama's historic brewing culture.

Luggage Handling:

- Luggage delivery will be arranged from Hakone to Kyoto (1 bag per person).

- Prepare an overnight bag.

Day 06: 27 Sep 2027, Mon | Takayama – Shirakawa go - Kanazawa

A morning visit (via private coach) to **Takayama's Morning Market**, where guests can browse vibrant stalls filled with local produce, crafts, and regional specialties, followed by lunch at a local restaurant featuring traditional mountain cuisine. The journey continues to Shirakawa-go to explore the **Gassho-zukuri** folk house museum, highlighting the village's iconic thatched-roof architecture, and concludes with a serene stroll through Kenrokuen Garden, one of Japan's most celebrated landscape gardens known for its seasonal beauty and tranquil atmosphere.



At the end of the tour, you will be transferred to the hotel in Kanazawa via private coach for check-in.

Day 07: 28 Sep 2027, Tue | Kanazawa - Kyoto

A journey from Kanazawa to Tsuruga and onward to Kyoto via Shinkansen and Limited Express, followed by visits to the atmospheric **Nagamachi Samurai District**, known for its preserved residences and earthen walls, and the charming **Higashi Chaya Geisha District**, famous for its traditional teahouses and historic streets. The day concludes at the iconic Fushimi Inari Shrine, with its thousands of vibrant torii gates, and a memorable dinner then a Maiko experience, offering a unique cultural experience with traditional dance, conversation, and Kyoto hospitality.

Day 08: 29 Sep 2027, Wed | Kyoto's Cultural Highlights

A full day exploring Kyoto's highlights begins with a visit to the brilliant Golden Pavilion (**Kinkakuji**), followed by the historic **Kiyomizu-dera Temple** overlooking the city. Guests then enjoy lunch at a local restaurant featuring regional Kyoto cuisine. The afternoon continues in **Arashiyama**, where visitors wander through the tranquil Bamboo Grove and experience a traditional rickshaw ride through the scenic district before returning to Kyoto for the evening.

Day 09: 30 Sep 2027, Thu | Nara Excursion

Transfers will be provided via private coach from Kyoto and back.

A cultural excursion to Nara, featuring a visit to the majestic **Todaiji Temple**, home to the Great Buddha and one of Japan's most historically significant landmarks, followed by a walk through the serene grounds of **Kasuga Taisha Shrine**, famous for its hundreds of stone and bronze lanterns and peaceful forest settings.

Day 10: 01 Oct 2027, Fri | Hiroshima & Miyajima Island

A full day traveling from Kyoto to Hiroshima via Shinkansen. Upon arrival, guests explore the impactful **Peace Memorial Park s Museum**, reflecting on Hiroshima's history and resilience, before taking a round-trip ferry to Miyajima Island to visit the iconic **Floating Torii Gate** of Itsukushima Shrine. The day concludes with a return journey from Hiroshima to Osaka by Shinkansen.

This morning after breakfast, A dynamic day in Osaka featuring a visit to the historic **Osaka Castle**, one of Japan's most iconic landmarks surrounded by beautiful park grounds, followed by time in the lively **Dotonbori District**, famous for its neon signs, street food, and vibrant atmosphere. The day concludes with a guided bicycle or e-bike ride, offering an enjoyable way to explore Osaka's neighborhoods and scenic riverside paths.
